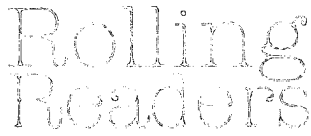

The grant provided a book for each 1<sup>st</sup> grader in the seven Title 1 Schools in the San Marcos Unified School District. In addition, Rotary members went to each class to present the book, impress on students the critical nature of learning to read effectively, and to read to the class an excerpt from the book. This was as proposed.

4. I think the reading to the class and the presentation of the book can be strengthened by intentionally emphasizing how truly fundamental reading is to personal fulfillment and ultimate success. Out of the process emerged the catch phrase "Today a Reader. Tomorrow a Leader".
