In early October 300 bikes were purchased by the Rotary Club of Chula Vista. December 3, 2013, the 300 bikes were assembled by the Rotary Club of Chula Vista, with help from the Rotary Club of Chula Vista Sunset, Chula Vista Kiwanis Club and Chula Vista Boy Scout troop 800 and Scout Pack 810. Helmets were organized to accompany each bicycle. Bicycles were distributed to South Bay nonprofits who qualify the bicycle recipients. 70 Bikes were given to the YMCA, 70 to the Kiwanis Club, 40 to Ronald McDonald House, 20 to Chula Vista Community Collaborative, 35 to Boys & Girls Club, 35 to South Bay Community Services, and 30 to Salvation Army.

Provide a brief (100 words or less) of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded projects:

After doing this project for over 35 years we have very good knowledge of the “ how to do part.” In recent years we have improved by going directly to the bicycle manufacturer to lower costs, including other service clubs and the Boy Scouts and adding helmets to the program. We need complete our Grant reporting faster. It may be better to have two people involved in the process.
