The Village of Montgomery Beautification Committee has a goal to develop a natural park and garden located near an historic silo, in front of the Montgomery Police Department. This project provides for the installation of a Park Bench. with an engraved plate recognizing the Club, within the Park/Garden, supporting the efforts of the Village Beautification Committee.

Although the actual completion of the garden has been delayed by the Village, the bench, and engraved plate, have been purchased and placed in storage until the garden is complete.
