Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project outcomes. What was done (in 100 words or less)? Help was needed to repair damage from flooding at the DOVES residence caused by deteriorating water pipes. Housing for victims of late-life elder abuse and domestic violence was disturbed. The Area Agency On Aging received funds from many sources including those provided through the Sun City Rotary Club. These funds were directed to major repairs that enabled residents to continue to live in their individual units. The plumbing bill was \$71,000. There were other expenses for electricity. The \$2,000 received from this Rotary International District 5495 Grant was applied to rebuilding the plumbing.

The project is on- going. Repairs are underway. For protection of the residents, Doves can not disclose the exact address of the housing in Maricopa County.

Who were the beneficiaries? Adults age 50 and older who are victims of violence and elder abuse.


