- 2. Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were involved?
- 3. The Greeley Redeye Rotary was a Principle Sponsor for the 10th Annual School Kickoff community Celebration, held Saturday, August 5, 2023, at Island Grove Regional Event Center in Greeley. The club matched the \$2,500 district grant it received to provide \$5,000 for this event, which provides backpacks filled with school supplies to students in Greeley-Evans School District 6.

This year, 3,500 backpacks were distributed during the three-hour event. The Greeley Redeye Rotary sponsorship helped fund 300 backpacks and the school supplies they contained. Seven of our club members volunteered, either to help place sponsor information in the backpacks the day before the event or to give out backpacks the day of the event. In addition to giving out backpacks, the event provided 237 low-cost sports physicals to students, had 60 community vendors who provided resources and activities for families, and included a petting zoo put on by the FAA chapter at Greeley West High School. The district also provided 3,000 free lunches to students, as well as worked with the Weld County Health Department to provide free vaccinations to students at the

event. The school district estimates that about 7,000 people attended the School Kickoff Community Celebration.
