1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

LB Rotary partially underwrote Theatre on the Spectrum production of Alice by Heart on March 16th at 3 pm at the No Square Theatre community theater in Laguna Beach. The production was adapted for ASD (Autism Spectrum Disorder) kids and their families. The donated funds went to adapt the show to a sensory-friendly production, with lighting and audio adjusted to remove abrupt changes, the length shortened to an hour and by reducing the volume from the live musicians.

Prior to the event, Laguna Beach Rotary club members helped with marketing (as requested by the theatre) by reaching out to families in the community to build awareness about the production. The day of the production, Rotary was on hand before and after the show to provide assistance as needed.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

Committee of 4 Rotarians worked with on this project and engaged Club members.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Prior to the event, Laguna Beach Rotary club members helped with marketing (as requested by the theatre) by reaching out to families in the community to build awareness about the production. The day of the production, club members were on hand before and after the show to usher audience members to their seats and provide any additional assistance.

This adapted presentation brought musical theater to an audience of 50 that included ASD children and their families. Laguna Beach and surrounding area families with ASD children.


