- 1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? This project was designed to support the Casa Romantica Cultural Center and Gardens, a San Clemente nonprofit organization and registered historic landmark that promotes arts, culture, and education to people of all ages. This historic icon experienced damage from several landslides over the past year. This grant, along with our club's volunteer efforts, helped support the continued operation of the Casa.
- 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 10
- 3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Three Rotarians volunteered on the Casa grounds, assisting with gardening and events. Others sold puzzles at our weekly Farmer's Market booth (this year's puzzle fundraiser theme was Casa Romantica) with proceeds going to the Casa. We also donated \$1,000 worth of puzzles as an in-kind donation, which the Casa Romantica sold at their gift shop (with support of Rotarian volunteers).

- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Hundreds of residents and visitors that enjoy the programs of the Casa Romantica.
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

With the support of community grant projects like this, the Casa Romantica Cultural Center and Gardens has been able to keep its doors open, and maintain the valuable community programming that is offered on the grounds. This center is a cornerstone of San Clemente for people of all ages and backgrounds, and the preservation of its services helps to foster a unified and improving community for the future.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Casa Romantica was involved in supporting Rotarian volunteers on the grounds, and selling puzzles at their gift shop that we donated.
