The project’s mission is the restoration of the: ecological health, functions, aesthetic value and community use of Kane Park by replacing some of its sod grass turf with native plantings.

Mr. Brussel’s work was brought to our club’s attention by Mark Kramer, Co-Chair of the Town of Mamaroneck Sustainability Collaborative and the Sheldrake Environmental Center.

Our funding went towards the purchase of native plants, gardening tools, trash bags and other equipment which were used, beginning in April. In addition, our club did volunteer work on the project.
