We will invite our Interactors and Rotaractors to participate in this project. Tara's Chance will utilize its donors to construct the foundation and supports needed for the shed. We will also have a Rotary plaque displayed on the shed to show our appreciation and share the amazing work of Rotary with all who visit Tara's Chance.
