The Rotary Club of Mission Viejo is undertaking a project to enhance the garden area at Linda Vista Elementary School in Mission Viejo, CA. Linda Vista is a Title 1 school whose students come from vulnerable population.

The project involves installing new fencing with a gate around the garden plot to ensure its security, adding additional planting beds to expand the garden's capacity, and purchasing gardening tools for the students. This initiative aims to create a safe, functional, and educational space where students can learn about gardening, ecology, and sustainability through hands-on activities. The project will foster a sense of responsibility, teamwork, and community among the students, while promoting environmental awareness and physical well-being.

Members of the Rotary Club of Mission Viejo will play an active and hands-on role in the Linda Vista Garden Enhancement Initiative. Their involvement will span all phases of the project, from planning and design to installation and ongoing support. During the planning phase, members will collaborate with school staff and gardening experts to design the layout of the new fencing, gate, and planting beds, and source the necessary materials and tools. In the construction phase, members will volunteer their time to install the fencing and gate, construct the planting beds, and ensure the garden structures are secure and durable. It is anticipated that the majority of the club's members will participate in some form.

The funds will be held in the club's checking account and managed according to standard accounting practices.

8. Describe how your club will use the project funds (list the types of expenses / items to be purchased):

Project funds will be used to enhance the garden area at Linda Vista Elementary School by covering various essential expenses. The funds will be allocated towards the purchase of high-quality materials for installing secure fencing and a gate around the garden plot, ensuring the safety and accessibility of the area. Additionally, the funds will be used to construct new planting beds, expanding the garden's capacity for student involvement. Essential gardening tools, including trowels, spades, watering cans, gloves, and other equipment, will be procured to facilitate hands-on learning experiences for the students. Other miscellaneous supplies needed for the project's successful execution, such as soil, seeds, and educational materials, will also be covered.
