

What is Period Poverty?



2 in 5 people have struggled to purchase period products



1 in 3 low income people reported missing work, school or similar events due to lack of access to period supplies



1 in 4 students struggle to afford period supplies and miss school



In 2023, we distributed **220,949** period products to individuals in need across Southern and Central Arizona.
