- With the assistance of 20 volunteers from the community, El Modena Interact and other Rotary clubs, we packed 11,400 "Stop Hunger Now" packages containing proteins, dried vegetables and rice. The event was held October 17, 2015 in the El Modena High School Cafeteria.
- 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 15
- 3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Volunteers set up and maintained the packing stations - tables, one for each team, that had bins of rice, dried vegetables and rice that refilled from bulk packages during the event

Volunteers filled individual baggies with meal mixture - working in teams, filled plastic bags with the dried food mixture, measuring precise amounts.

Volunteer runners - including children ages 4 and up, ran filled baggies to the boxing station to be packed into cardboard

Volunteer boxers - filled shipping boxes, counting completed packages as they went.

- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 45,600 (each box feeds a family of 4)
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

In our community, this volunteer event that included non-Rotarians and their children raised awareness of world hunger issues and instilled community service values.

In the recipient countries, addressing hunger needs allows the recipients to focus on other family and community needs, building stronger communities.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Stop Hunger Now is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization that supplies all food materials, equipment and shipping boxes. SHN also provided personnel to train volunteers and took the completed shipment to their warehouse. From there, the boxes were shipped to families in Vietnam.

Memo of Understanding

Between Stop Hunger Now and Orange Plaza Rotary

Stop Hunger Now's meal packaging program is a fun, hands-on international mission project where volunteers work in an assembly line to package high protein, vitamin rich meals.

Stop Hunger Now will:

- Provide a facilitator to conduct the meal packaging event.
- Provide necessary ingredients, packaging materials, and equipment.
- Receive and distribute packaged meals.

Participant will:

- Recruit the number of volunteers based on the target number of meals to be packaged.
- Fundraise \$0.29 per meal based on the target number of meals. Payments must be made to Stop Hunger Now on or before the date of the packaging event.
 - For meal packaging events of 100,000 meals or more, we require that at least 50% of the payment due be made 30 days prior to the event.
 - Checks are to be made payable to Stop Hunger Now and mailed to the address above prior to the event or should be presented prior to or on the day of the event.

On-site Event requirements:

- Large room or social hall and adequate tables (event site must be indoors). Size of the packaging space and number of tables needed will be determined by the number of volunteers participating.
- Long-term parking near the packaging room or a space at the loading dock.
- Five to ten people for setup and breakdown of the event. More volunteers may be needed for larger events. This includes assistance in the unloading and reloading of the truck before and after the event. Supplies can weigh up to 50 lbs. If volunteers cannot be provided, the event host will employ/contract temporary labor, at host expense, to assist with the setup and breakdown of the event.
- Depending on the size of the event, 2-20 volunteers will need to lift 50 lb. bags of ingredients throughout the event.





Abandoned by her birth mother as a baby, Chloe blossomed after receiving nutritious Stop Hunger Now meals at a children's home.
