FOCUS AREA



DISEASE PREVENTION AND TREATMENT

Beneficiaries

- Economically Weaker and Lower Middle Class Community IPD Patients need Quality treatment in affordable charges.
- They cannot afford the expensive treatments in Private hospitals.
- In daily Ophthalmic OPD of around 50 to 60 nos, average 12 patients need cataract surgery treatment.
- At present hospital is performing 140 150 surgeries per month.
- After addition of equipments, hospital will be able to conduct 300 325 surgeries per month.

Beneficiary Institution : Seth Tarachand Ramnath Charitable Hospital

Need Assessment

- Present available operative microscope and Phaco machine are 10 years old. As the models are outdated, it is difficult to get the spares & service for these machines.
- These compromised machines makes it difficult to carry out cataract operations.
- Yag Laser is not currently available. Hence patients has to be sent to other hospitals.
- Low income patients find it hard to pay the charges of private hospitals.
- Due to poor condition of machines very few surgeries can be done per day resulting in long queue and high wait time.

- SHIN Japan make Non contact Tonometer NCT 200,
- Ophthalmic Refraction Chair unit with Surgeon stool,

- Ophthalmic Ultra Sound Scanner,
- Indirect Ophthalmoscope,
- Yag Laser equipment.
- Cataract Surgery Set 10 sets
- Funding for 100 nos. cataract surgeries which will be free to beneficiaries.

About Beneficiary Institute

- Seth Tarachand Ramnath Charitable Hospital is 95 years old and is centrally located in Pune city.
- 100 % charity through funds generated from Donors in the community , NGO's and through CSR funding.
- Hospital associated with Tilak Ayurvedic Medical College from last 80 years. So nursing staff and resident Doctors are always available.
- Existing IPD Capacity = 236 Beds. They have future expansion plans also.
- Well planned and constructed building with 4 well equipped OT's and other supportive set up.
- Our Club has upgraded & expanded 8 NICU beds to 16 beds in Global Grant Project No.2231147 in the March 2022. It is providing life saving treatments to neonates in subsidized cost.

About Beneficiary Institute

- Current OPD case paper charges are Rs.20/- (\$ 0.26) and IPD charges are Rs.50/per day (\$ 0.66) per day. Where as private hospital charges are minimum 10 to 15 times higher.
- Expert Doctors provide their services in minimal cost for charity.
- From last 5 years Average data per year is as
 OPD's --- 97000, IPD admissions 47000 and Surgeries 3500
- All Trustees have main objective to provide best quality treatment in affordable cost to economically weaker community.
- Have adequate and suitable premises for OPD, OT & ICU set up.





Project Sustainability

- Private hospital charges Rs.10000 to 12000 for cataract surgeries where as in Tarachand it is done free of cost for BPL community. The surgery cost of Rs.2500/- is received by hospital through donations and CSR.
- Because of free surgery, the hospital has the BPL patients in wait list.
- The equipments to be donated are with maintenance cost for 4 years. So for first 4 years hospital will not have any financial burden for maintenance.
- The hospital Trust owns commercial premises in nearby campus which are rented out. The amount received is utilized for Salaries and will be utilized in future for maintenance also.
- Hospital plans to built up a corpus fund for maintenance in future.
- Hospital has graduation as well as post graduation course in ophthalmic which is associated with their own Tilak Ayurvedic Medical College in same premises. So resident staff as well as nursing staff is available for 24 Hrs.
- So sustainability is not at all an issue on the front of Patients number, equipment maintenance and skilled staff.
