IDP Challenge of Ukraine



- Over 7 million people displaced, including25% children
- Limited access to basic services, housing shortages, and economic instability
- Mental health issues, such as PTSD and depression



Why Film School?

- Through the process of making films, children can express their experiences, emotions, and perspectives, helping them to process trauma and build resilience
- © Collaborative and engaging activity conducive to healing and personal growth
- Learning practical skills in a creative and stimulating environment
- Film projects raise awareness about the experiences of displaced children and contribute to advocacy efforts on their behalf.


