Rajavithi Hospital, a well known academic Gynecology, has been currently at the forefront of many researches, encouraged to the development among the trust from people especially for Obstetrics an gynecology(OB/GYN). However, Doppler Fetus Detector, an instrument utilized Doppler Effect for velocity measurements allow assessment of child's cardiac valve for during pregnant, is facing needs problem, which conditional tools cannot cope with gradual patients increases while government budget limited. Matching Grant Project: Doppler Fetus Detector towards Rajavithi Hospital

Type of service project: Maternal and Child Health

Project responsible person: Rotary Club, Sukhumvit-Bangkok

Principal and rationale





Quality of the youth starts since the children are in womb. Taking care of physical aspect and mind is important, but because of economic readiness, most families wait for service from the public sector causing crowdedness and waiting queue for service to be in a long queue.

Medical equipment is also deteriorated more quickly than normal time. Provision of effective equipment has to wait for approval for a long time, so doctors who do medical treatment lack effective equipment to provide service to service users. In Rajavithi Hospital, there are 7 health check rooms for pregnancy. Each room, there is checking in average number of 30 patients per day; the total number is 210 patients per day. Rajavithi Hospital opens for service for 260 days per year. Therefore, there are about 54,600 pregnant patients per year (patients may be the same patients) having problems of the Doppler Fetus Detectors being deteriorated and the number of Doppler Fetus Detectors is not sufficient; so checking of mothers' wombs is in delay. Mothers have to wait for using. Pregnant mothers who check up their health do not have opportunity to touch love and relationship to listen to their child's heart that is beating since the fetus is in womb, so that mother will have more inspiration to take care of fetus so that fetus will have quality as much as possible; therefore, providing of 11 doppler fetus detectors in type of primary and special kinds; will put more effectiveness of taking care of mothers and fetus so that they have good health physically and mentally.

Objectives

- 1. To have mothers and fetus who gain opportunity to take care will physically and mentally grow as good human being in the future.
- 2. To promote ethics in physician and nurse profession, so that physicians and nurses can take good care of service users not less than medical centers having a lot of budget.
- 3. To create friendship of members of Rotary Chub of Sukhumvit-Bangkok and third parties from performing a benevolent project.

Indicator of success

Qualitative aspect

Doctors and nurses use the doppler fetus detector and they are satisfied with the given equipment, for not less than 80 per cent.

Quantitative aspect

More mother and fetus obtain medical service quickly and precisely for not less than 10 per cent.

Method for following and evaluation of projects

• Evaluation about the number of pregnant patients obtaining service before and after preparing projects.
